PETITION TO ACCEPT SEVENTH STATUS REPORT FOR THE PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2018

(Assigned to The Honorable Daniel Martin)

Keith Schraad, Interim Director of Insurance, as Receiver (hereinafter "Receiver") of Compass Cooperative Mutual Health Network, Inc. dba as Meritus Mutual Health Partners ("Meritus Mutual") and Compass Cooperative Health Plan, Inc. dba Meritus Health Partners ("MHP"), appointed pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-611, *et seq.*, hereby petitions the Court for entry of the Order re Petition No. 23 Accepting Seventh Status Report for the Period Ending June 30, 2018 for the reasons set forth herein.

- 1. In an Order dated August 10, 2016, this Court placed Meritus Mutual and MHP into receivership under orders of liquidation.
- 2. On August 24, 2016, this Court entered Order Re Petition No. 1 Petition for Entry of Order Approving Compensation for Special Deputy Receiver and for Legal Counsel.
- a. Pursuant to Paragraph 3(c) of that Order, the Receiver is required to make periodic filings, initially quarterly, of a Petition to Accept Status Report, which filing is required to include amounts paid to the Special Deputy Receiver and to legal counsel during the period along with a brief summary of services and/or tasks performed during the period and other matters as requested by the Court.
- b. In order to provide such report for the prior period, consistent with Paragraph 3(c), the Receiver is submitting this Petition to Accept Seventh Status Report for the Period Ending June 30, 2018 ("Petition") after the quarter end of the prior period ending June 30, 2018. Unless the Court otherwise orders, the Receiver anticipates filing these reports effective each calendar quarter end.
- 3. This Petition along with the Status Report included herein is submitted in accordance with those requirements.

Summary of Services/Tasks

- 4. The services and tasks performed during the reporting period (Second Quarter of 2018) include the following:
- a. Proof of Claim ("POC") Process. During the second quarter of 2018, the Receiver continued evaluation of claims filed as part of the POC process, including considering claim amounts, priority levels and potentially offset, depending on the circumstances.
- b. Provider Payments. In the second quarter of 2018, in conjunction with the work associated with the Liquidation Plan, a significant amount of work

continued to focus on the processing of provider claims in order to implement the claims process with the providers.

- c. As part of the POC Process and processing the provider claims, the
 Receiver prepared and filed its Second Report on Claims to the Court dated June 28,
 2018.
- d. Accounting Services and General Accounting and Administrative. The Receiver contracted with Regulatory Services Group, subject to this Court's May 23, 2017 Order Re Petition No. 11 Approving Rates for Accounting Services. During the second quarter of 2018, additional work continued to be done on the accounting of the Meritus Companies in Liquidation, including work on a liquidation balance sheet.
- e. Third Party Documents. The Receiver previously issued several demands to third parties requesting production of documents. The Receiver continued the review and evaluation of the documents that have been produced along with documents otherwise in the possession of Meritus, which combined total more than 14,000 documents.
- f. Claims Involving Federal Government. The Receiver continued to review and consider claims against and asserted by the Federal Government associated with the Affordable Care Act. That review included, among other things, review of the other litigation around the country involving other co-ops.

Summary of Payments

5. Legal Counsel. During the reporting period, the total amounts (fees and expenses) that have been paid to legal counsel are \$53,753.00 for Meritus Mutual and \$54,018.28 for MHP for a combined amount of \$107,771.28. Work was performed and invoices were submitted for additional services and amounts during the reporting period but not paid until after June 30, 2018. Because of the timing, those payments will be referenced in the next status report.

	6.	Special Deputy Receiver. During the reporting period, the total amounts
(fe	es and exp	penses) that have been paid to the Special Deputy Receiver are \$16,963.73
for	Meritus N	Mutual and \$15,778.73 for MHP for a combined amount of \$32,742.46.

7. Regulatory Services Group. During the reporting period, no payments were made to the Regulatory Services Group. Work may have been performed and invoices submitted for additional services and amounts during the reporting period but not paid until after June 30, 2018. Because of the timing, any related payments would be referenced in the next status report.

WHEREFORE, the Receiver requests that the Court enter the Order re Petition No. 23 Accepting Seventh Status Report for the Period Ending June 30, 2018 in the form lodged concurrently with this Petition after expiration of the objection period.
